

Driving Park Animal Hospital Boarding Policies

Thank you for choosing our hospital to board your pet. We provide quality boarding and will make every attempt to give each pet individual love and attention during their visit with us. While staying with us your pet will be under the supervision of out trained staff and our Veterinarian. We strive to maintain a sanitary and healthy environment for our boarders.

Vaccinations: All pets must be up to date on vaccines. It is the owner's responsibility to make sure that proof of current vaccinations is on file with the hospital at the time of admission. If vaccinations have been given at another veterinary hospital the owner must furnish proof of those vaccines at the time of admission. Of vaccines are not up to date they will be given to each pet due at the time of admission and the owner will be charged accordingly. **Dogs Require: DHLPP, Bordetella, Rabies and Canine Influenza. Cats require: FVRCP and Rabies.**

Parasites: All pats must be free of parasites including fleas and ticks. If your pet(s) is found to have parasites a dose of an appropriate medication will be given and your account will be charge accordingly.

Rates and Payment: The current boarding rate is 25.00/day. Other services provided to your pet during their stay will be charged at regular cost Payment is expected in full at the time your pet(s) is discharged.

Personal Belongings: You may bring any toys, treat or personal items for your pet to make them more comfortable during their stay but please be advised that personal items can become soiled and potentially misplaced in the cleaning process. We cannot be responsible for any items lost or soiled.

Medical Attention: If your pet(s) needs medical attention while boarding with us we will make every attempt to contact you and/or the emergency contact you provided at check-in. If we are unable to reach you or your emergency contact how would you like us to proceed?

_____ please treat my pet(s) as the veterinarian deems necessary. I understand I will be responsible for any fees incurred in the course of treating my pet.

_____ please treat my pet up to the cost of \$_____ until I can be reached to discuss the problem and subsequent costs. ***In a life threatening situation the veterinarian reserves the to administer emergency treatment for your pet even if you or emergency contact cannot be reached***

Inherent Conditions/ Bites /Fights: Although animals are monitored, occasionally injuries may occur as a result of rough play. Animals can also develop illnesses related to the stress of a new environment or dietary changes. Signs may including vomiting, diarrhea, coughing, sneezing and self-trauma. We take care to ensure that these problems do not occur however when they do they will be treated promptly. Please be aware that the hospital is not financially responsible for any charges incurred to treat these ailments.

Abandonment: Please notify us if there is any change in your pet(s) scheduled release date. If you do not notify us of a change in the departure date and we do not hear from you or unable to contact you or your authorized agent for a period of 14 days after your pet's release date, the hospital will consider your pet abandoned. Please be advised that you will be responsible for the fees accrued and any other fees or legal services incurred as a result of the abandonment.
